



## **Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador upholds injunction for Muskrat Falls**

October 17, 2012, St. John's, NL - Today, the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador Trial Division has upheld an injunction against NunatuKavut Community Council, Todd Russell and persons unknown. The injunction allows Nalcor to continue its site construction work at Muskrat Falls without interruption.

The Court also accepted Nalcor Energy's proposal to build a "safety zone" for protestors. Nalcor has identified an area a safe distance from the work site where protestors can continue their demonstration in the vicinity without compromising their safety.

"Ensuring we operate a safe work environment is the most important thing we can do as a company. It's a responsibility we take very seriously," says Gilbert Bennett, Vice President, Lower Churchill Project. "We are working tirelessly to ensure safety on the Muskrat Falls site, and that includes the safety of workers and protestors."
