With curved, arching shapes, it has a constant sense of motion – representing the *flow of energy, wind, water and oil*. The movement in the symbol speaks to growth, mirroring the evolving nature of the energy industry and positioning Nalcor Energy as a leading, global player. With the segments joining together to form one circular shape, it symbolizes the synergy and balance of the different parts of the business working together as one.

The curved, streaming shapes formed by the white space symbolize entrance and exit points in the company. As resources enter the company, they are transformed to modern, usable power with our expertise and forward-thinking. Further, the white space forms the N and L of Newfoundland and Labrador – evoking a strong sense of internal pride and aligning with the vision of the company.

Because the existing brand of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro has been a strong anchor in the development of Nalcor Energy, the blue used draws upon the current Hydro logo for continuity, while also representing water, wind and the environment. The grey represents oil and gas, the powerful earth, and it anchors the logo – speaking to a strong parent company rooted in stability.
