



Media Advisory: Lower Churchill environmental assessment hearings begin in Happy Valley-Goose Bay

March 3, 2011 - Panel hearings for Nalcor Energy's Lower Churchill Hydroelectric Generation Project will begin at Hotel North 2 in Happy Valley-Goose Bay at 7:00 p.m. this evening.

The 45 day public hearings give interested individuals and organizations the opportunity to hear about the project and its potential impacts and to provide their views to the Joint Review Panel. At the hearings, Nalcor will present the project and clarify information as required.
